HOA SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING COMING UP

PARK AND COMMON AREA UPDATES

New Street Signs: Check out our new, more durable cast metal signs! Our old street signs with worn/missing lettering have been replaced. Big improvement!

Sidewalk: We now have a new sidewalk at the park to help those of you with strollers, wagons, bikes and wheelchairs easily get to the lower sidewalk.

Green Fence: We are working on a green buffer between Hwy 66 and the soccer field. Due to the cost, it will happen in phases over the next three years. Phase one is complete. When done, it will go across the whole end of the field. (Due to the flood zone, the city will not allow us to build a permanent fence.)

Bullying: We have had reports of harassment, bullying and inappropriate behavior at the park. This is disturbing; the park should be a place everyone can enjoy without fear. It's usually best to talk to the parents first, but if you have a problem you cannot solve directly, please contact the Yukon police. *Reminder: children should be accompanied by parents and we ask parents to make sure their children behave at the park and follow the rules.*

OVERNIGHT PARKING STILL AN ISSUE

Our Safety & Compliance Committee is working on a new system to enforce our covenant prohibiting vehicles from being parked on our streets overnight. More information will be provided when it is finalized.
